## INTEGRATED CAD/CAM/CAE SYSTEMS II

## REGULATIONS

- 1. During the course the students are obliged to obey the regulations of study at The Warsaw University of Technology as well as the safety and user regulations being in force in the CAD/CAE/CAM Systems Laboratory.
- 2. The course is run in a separate group of students called "English Language Group" according to the division made by the registry.
- 3. Only the student who is registered for this course can complete it.
- 4. The presence at all classes of the course is obligatory and checked.
- 5. In order to complete the course one has to get positive grade/s from one or more tests (depending on the tutor decision) held during the course. The final grade includes the "continuous assessment" of the student gathered during the course (attendance at classes, commitment to learning, activity in tutorials)

- The number of tests should be announced not later than by the end of the second week of the semester.

- 6. The student who does not fulfill the requirement mentioned in point 5 but got the positive grade from "continuous assessment" has a chance to complete the course by taking an additional test called "the improvement test".
- 7. "The improvement test" is organized once at the end of the semester (but before the end of classes). This test covers the whole material of the course.
- 8. In extraordinary cases the Head of the Fundamentals of Machine Design Department takes the decision concerning completing the course.
